I also will publish my list of the surnames that were still living in Mariental in 1941 (before many were sent to Siberia.) This list will be in one of the newsletters yet this year. There is a great need for more information. I have received four requests from searchers in Germany – and one from Argentina. The e-mails got my name as Mariental Village Coordinator from my web page, and AHSGR. It was nice to hear from them. There seems to be more people from foreign countries searching for information we might have over here. Two other inquiries from other countries were not for my Mariental, but apparently for one of the other Mariental villages. (There are five of them).

This list was initially created by using the HeritageQuest U.S. Federal Census Records (fee service) advanced search. Search "State" Kansas and "Born in" Argentina, Brazil, and South America. I then manually choose those with Russia connections. Gary Ubert, Topeka, Kansas

WHISPER:

Hanjoerg Linenberger was born in 1767. He lived in Mariental, Russia. He herded sheep and pigs for his parents. While the Kirghiz tribes were raiding the Russian colonies, he was kidnapped. He was nine years old in 1776. For eleven years he tended their sheep, and traveled with them via horseback. Sold from one master to another. he finally escaped with a Tartan, who also had been a prisoner of the Kirghiz. One day a Kirghiz girl furnished him a fast horse and food to last several days. He sold his horse, and with the money bought a boat ticket. A farmer took him and the Tartan to Belokowo, a city on the Volga river. From there he took a boat to Saratov. He had forgotten the German language, so a note was sent with him explaining where he wanted to go. After proper identification by a birthmark, he was reunited with his parents who had been sorrowing for their only son all these years. He was now 20 years old. After his parents died, he married Margaret Fischer. From these two are all of the descendents who have the Linenberger blood in their veins.
